REMOTE ACCESS FOR THE ONLINE LIBRARY RESOURCES

A new school year has started and the North Dakota State Library would like to provide you with your "remote access" barcode number and password. This number and password will allow your students, teachers, and community members to access the Online Library Resources that are available through your school. **This barcode number and password will not allow students and faculty to place interlibrary loan requests; it only provides remote access to the Online Library Resources.** All of the Online Library Resources are available remotely off site, with the exception of Ancestry Library Edition, which must be accessed onsite at your school. Please put this notice in a safe place for future reference. You may also contact the North Dakota State Library at 1-800-472-2104 or e-mail us at statelib@nd.gov and we can provide you with your barcode number and password.

You may pass this number out to teachers, administrators, students, and community members. You may print this number and password on bookmarks, business cards, or simply write it on a corner of the board. You can incorporate it into a bulletin board or a display. We ask that you do not publish this number in your local newspaper or place it on your web page.
